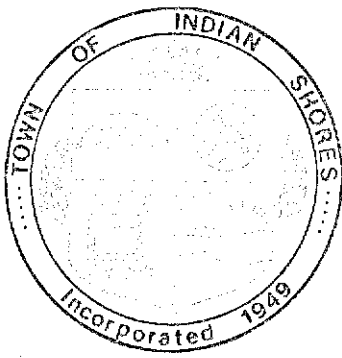

3.0 Consideration of recommendation of the Ad Hoc Beautification Committee to approve the selection of the white, Rubbermaid Classic I mailbox for uniformity on Gulf Boulevard and the purchase of twelve boxes to be installed in the showplace area from 193rd Avenue going north on the west side of Gulf Boulevard, as well as providing help with installation and numbering.

Councilor Smith stated this was all discussed at the Beautification Committee meeting on July 7, 2009, and we want to move forward and keep the momentum going.

MOTION by Councilor Irelan – seconded by Councilor Smith – to recommend Council approve the selection of the white, Rubbermaid Classic I mailbox for uniformity on Gulf Boulevard and the purchase of twelve boxes to be installed in the showplace area from 193rd Avenue going north on the west side of Gulf Boulevard, as well as providing help with installation and numbering. Motion carried 3-0.

- 4.0 Consideration of recommendation of the Ad Hoc Beautification Committee to approve trash receptacles made of white concrete, rectangular with rounded corners, with a white, blue and yellow tile design, and with a permanently affixed top designed with one or two side drops for use in bus shelter areas.*

Chief Williams advised the price would be possibly in the \$500.00 range, noting he would have more information at the Council meeting on 7/28/09.

MOTION by Councilor Smith – seconded by Councilor Irelan – to recommend Council approve trash receptacles made of white concrete, rectangular with rounded corners, with a white, blue and tallow tile design, and with a permanently affixed top designed with one or two side drops for use in bus shelter areas. Motion carried 3-0.

- 5.0 Consideration of recommendation of the Ad Hoc Beautification Committee to approve the landscaping concept in bus shelter areas with Crepe Myrtle trees, Downey Jasmine bushes and Vinca Cora ground cover, as presented by Bob Brotherton.*

Councilor Irelan noted that while Crepe Myrtles are beautiful they are not real salt tolerant, even though Bob Brotherton, Engineer, had reported beautiful ones in bloom along Bayshore Boulevard where the cities of Clearwater and Dunedin meet.

Councilor Smith reported he and his wife had driven up there to look at the trees noting there were not many of them and they did not look very good, and stated the ones in Indian Shores appear anemic.

Committee agreed a few could be planted and see how they hold up, and replaced in the future if necessary.

Chief Williams reported permission is needed from FDOT to landscape around the bus shelters, advising he believes the southern most shelter and the one across from Tiki Park are on County property. He further reported he is meeting with a County representative on Friday to discuss another item and he will discuss the shelters at that time also.

Chief Williams advised a "Right of Entry Agreement" would be needed for any work on private property, however he did not believe that would be a problem.

Chief Williams stated he thought the Silver Buttonwood was an attractive tree.

Chief Williams advised he would have more info on the tree plantings at the Council meeting on 7/28/09.

MOTION by Councilor Irelan – seconded by Councilor Smith – to recommend Council approve the landscaping concept in bus shelter areas with Crepe Myrtle trees, Downey Jasmine bushes and Vinca Cora ground cover, subject to more information being presented on trees at the Council meeting on 7/28/09. Motion carried 3-0.

Marcia - The quote below does not include the cost of the can liners or the can lids. These liners and lids can be purchased from sales@belson.com. This is the company whose lid and liner was used to come up with the design of the trash receptacles quoted below. The liners cost \$54.00 each and the lids cost \$109.00 each. The liner product number is TF1640 and the plastic lid number is TF 1445. Both of these should be ordered in the light gray color. We should order 8 of each of these two items. The concrete trash receptacles will be almost white with a slight gray tint. The Town should order all lids and liners before the order is placed with Florida Statuary and Molds. Florida Statuary and Molds needs one of these lids and liners to properly design the final casting. The total cost for each of these trash receptacles will be about \$613 which is much less than the cost to order similar concrete trash receptacles delivered from companies as investigated in catalogs by the Beautification Committee. It is important to have a heavy container that will not be blown into the street from high winds and at the same time be custom designed for Indian Shores with the seagull logo and special art work. This concrete art will be in relief, that is, not recessed but extending out from the surface. What is not shown in the picture of the large frontal art work is that the words "INDIAN SHORES" will be placed in a circular pattern in the lower left side below the heron. This work was not completed at the time the photo was taken but will be included in the final casting. The City staff will have to prepare the ground by removing the sod and placement of a level gravel pad with compaction if an adequate size concrete pad is not available at the bus stop. The concrete trash container will have a hole in the bottom to allow drainage. The concrete trash container will also be drilled on the back panel for the City Staff to add a bolt to attach a connector between the lid and the trash receptacle in case the lid blows off.

I believe that the cost is very reasonable for the quality of the final product and will provide a very beautiful addition to the Town Streetscape Theme along Gulf Blvd. and will also provide a special identity for the Town of Indian Shores. More of these can be added in the future at beach access points, Town Hall, and other points as desired since the molds will be retained by this company for future orders.

Here is our quote for the trash receptacles.....

Quote # fsm 0016 is for 8 cast concrete cover for trash receptacles. Without having in house the liner to measure from we are using the estimate of 34" to 38" high and 24" to 28" wide.

Basic wall thickness will be 2" minimum. As for the concrete strengths and reinforcements we will use only "Strux" polypropylene fiber and add mixtures from W. R. Grace Company. If needed, fiberglass re-bar can be used. Our concrete will be about 3500 to 5500 PSI. Recess for additional sculptured panels. All plaque sizes and locations are at the discretion of the customer. Designed with rounded bottom for limited chipping when moved and additional stability.

Each receptacle will have a sculptured design of chosen sculpture (large plaque to be chosen before casting of receptacles and 2 smaller sculpture plaques to be from our inventory) on 3 sides. We will cast and install plaques before to delivery.

Receptacles can be white, Gray or Our Sandstone color concrete. Smooth or textured surface finish \$450.00, including affixed plaques, each including delivery (if able to deliver to each location in one day. If deliveries require additional days cost is \$120.00 per hour).

Before we are able to produce these receptacles, we will need a trash insert and cover on which we will design our mold for casting.

We will require 25% deposit for making molds and sculptures. Plaques made for this project will be available for critique and changes by an appointed city representative but once accepted any further changes are additional costs.

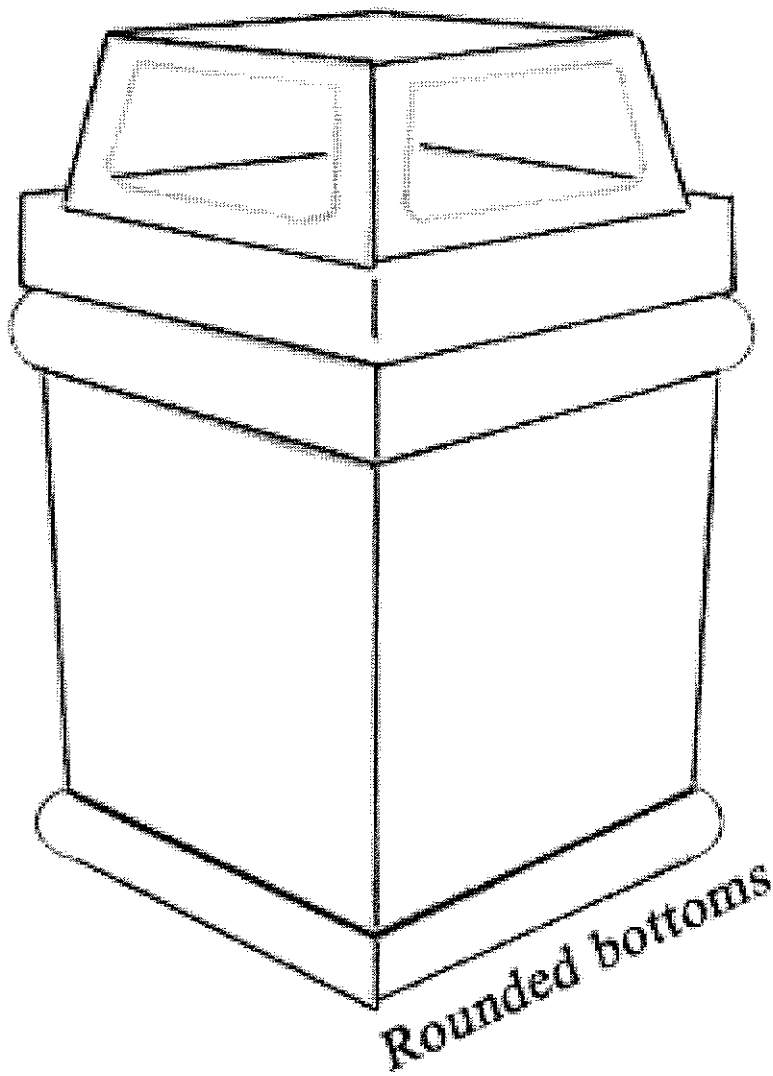
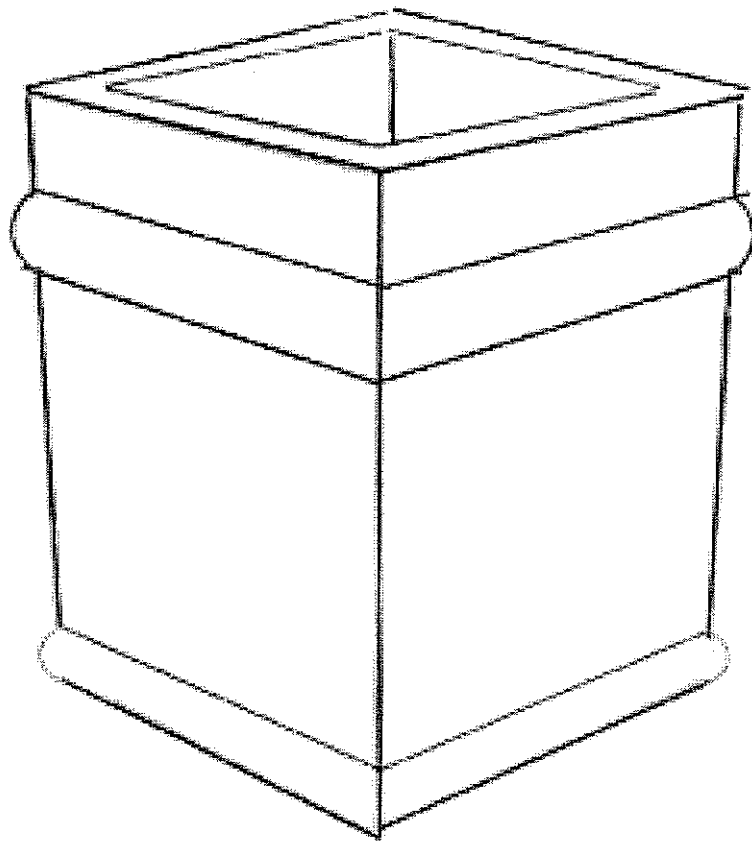

Marcia - In past correspondence with the Town, I have supplied photos of three options of benches that can be made for bus stops in Indian Shores that do not have a bus shelter. These are made by the Florida Statuary and Mold Company in St. Petersburg, Florida. Prices for these three options are quoted below. I personally prefer the scroll bench but this is a decision to be made by the Beautification Committee. Any of these benches should have the addition of a small raised section in the center to discourage sleeping on these by vagrants. This raised section can be added at no additional cost. One advantage of the scroll bench is that this comes in various lengths as may be desirable for different sites based on usage documentation by the Bus Company. These will also be cast using the same white concrete similar to the trash recepticals. The benches come with a special connection device into the ground to prevent theft.

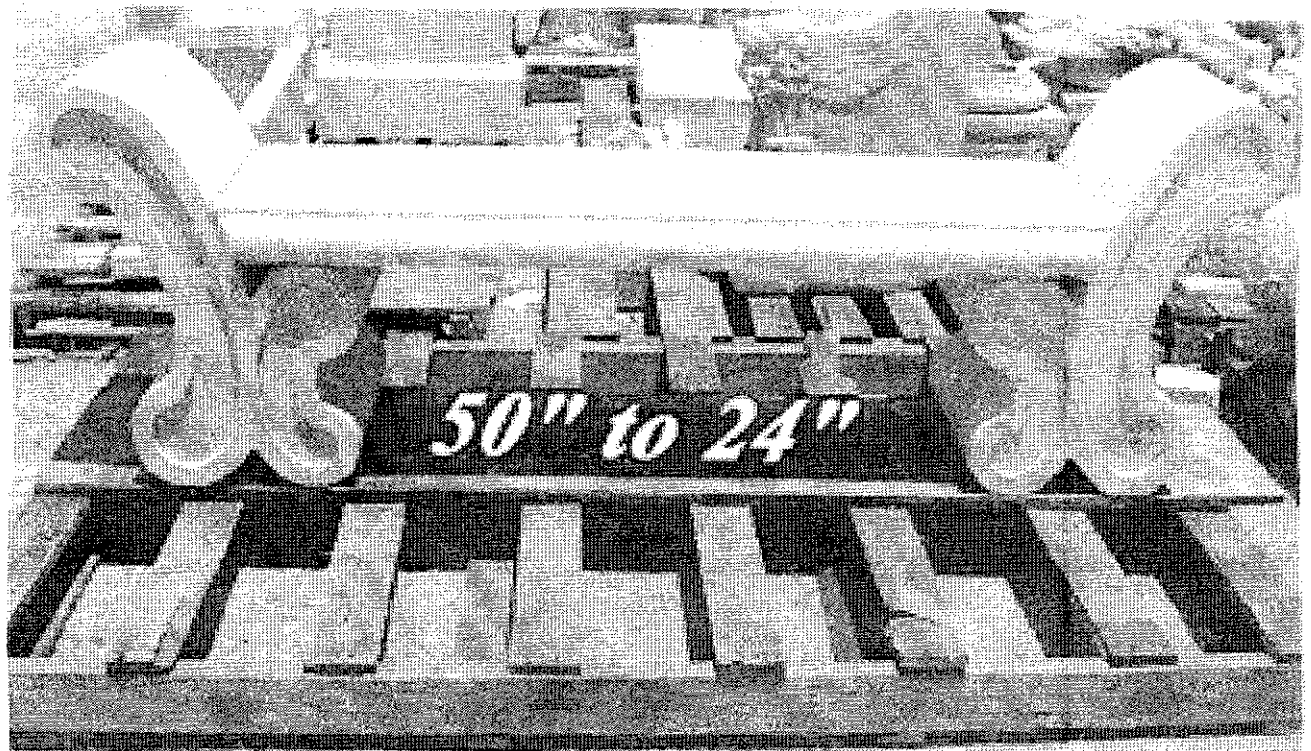
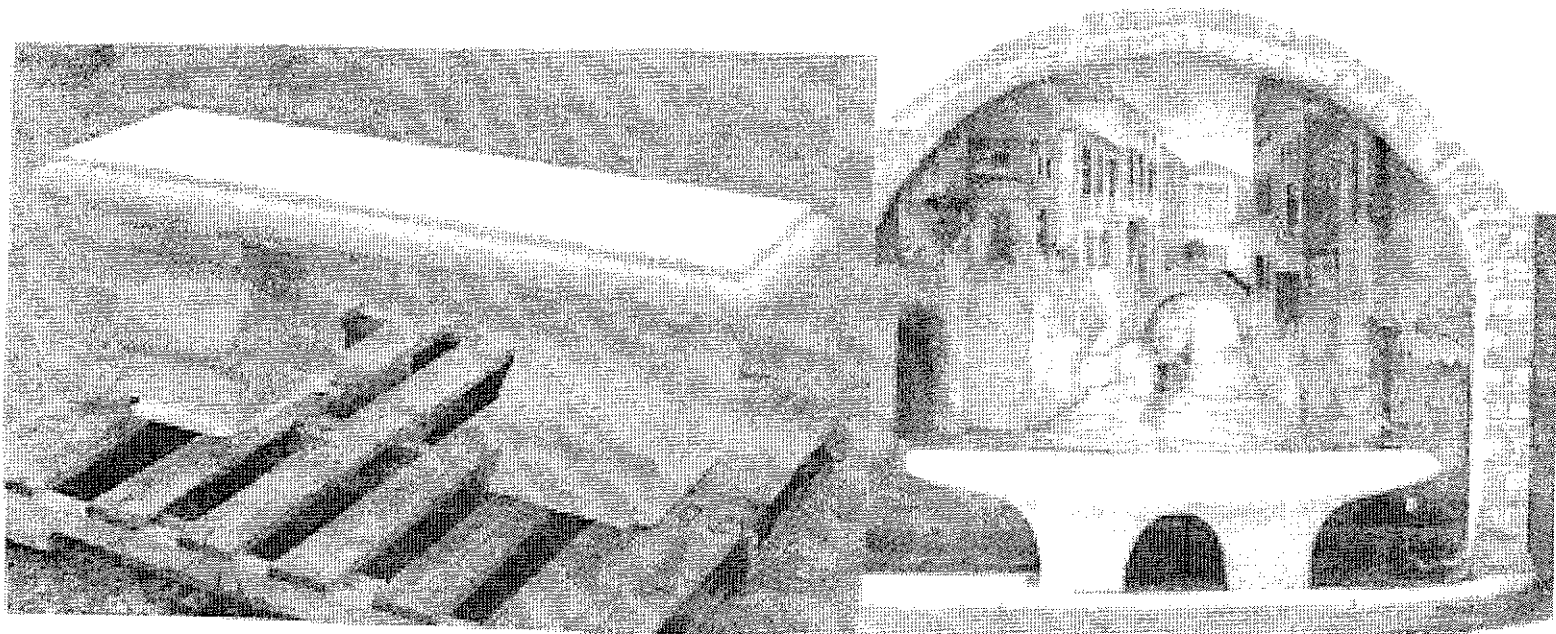
