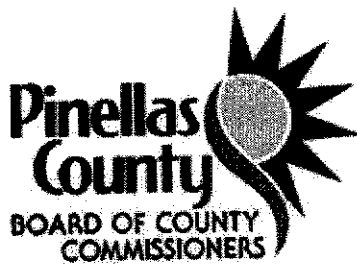

Hours Extended for Businesses Selling Alcohol

Business establishments in Pinellas County that sell alcoholic beverages now have the option to stay open until 3 a.m. The new limit on closing times is effective July 30.

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners passed an ordinance at its July 27 meeting to allow the change in hours. The prior time that establishments were required to close was 2 a.m. Businesses had requested the commission to consider the change in hours, to allow uniform regulation on a countywide basis. Municipalities have the discretion to set earlier closing hours, but they may not set later hours.

Sec. 6-3. Closing hours for business establishments serving alcoholic beverages, hours of sale of beer or wine for off-the-premises consumption and hours of sale of liquor for off-the-premises consumption.

(a) F.S. § 562.14 is hereby superseded.

(b) All business establishments in the town, licensed or unlicensed, dealing in alcoholic beverages, intoxicating beverages or intoxicating liquors, public or private, shall remain closed and shall not serve and/or sell alcoholic beverages, intoxicating beverages or intoxicating liquor from the hour of 2:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. each day of the week except Sunday.

(c) All such business establishments shall remain closed and shall not serve and/or sell alcoholic beverages, intoxicating beverages or intoxicating liquor on each Sunday from the hour of 2:00 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(d) *Closed* shall mean that the business establishment may not be occupied by any customer or guest. Only the owner, manager and employees of same may lawfully enter or occupy the premises during closed hours.

(e) Vendors licensed under Florida Statutes shall not dispense beer or wine for off-the-premise consumption between the hours of 12:00 p.m. midnight and 8:00 a.m. each week weekday, and between the hours of 12:00 p.m. midnight Saturday and 11 a.m. Sunday.

(f) Vendors licensed under Florida Statutes shall not dispense liquor for off-the-premise consumption between the hours of 12:00 p.m. midnight and 8:00 a.m. each weekday, and between the hours of 12:00 p.m. midnight Saturday and 11:00 a.m. Sunday.
