As you know this proposed program has been around for many years. Bob Hauser has been asked to bring the project before the Board of County Commissioners for their approval. Since it has been a while since we touched base, I am making contact with the proposed participants to be sure our previously gathered information is still valid.

We have Indian Shores included in Phase 1 which is defined as needing recycling receptacles but having the collection service in place. You would be collecting and dropping the recyclables at your city drop off center. We would be providing the city with 12 collection containers. We have identified 32 gallon containers as the ideal size but will take quotes for containers between 30-35 gallons in size.

When you have a chance, please look over this information and determine if Indian Shores is still on board with the project as I have described. I will call you or you can call me at 464-7533. Thanks for your continued interest and I look forward to speaking to you.
