Re: Request for Authorization – Purchase of Service Agreement for Police Radios

We have had our police radios in service for four years now and are beginning to experience some technical issues.

To prevent escalation of technical issues from becoming public safety issues, request is being made to enter into a service agreement with the County's radio vendor, Suncoast Communications & Electronics, Inc. This service agreement will be for a year of troubleshooting and maintenance on our radios.

Cost of the agreement is \$1,890 for 15 radios for 12 months with a 10% pre-pay option bringing the cost down to \$1,701. There are funds available in the Communication Services budget to cover this expense.

- 1) Reported Crimes and Police Action Reports, including miscellaneous reports, were UP in Indian Shores while DOWN in Redington Shores. The same trend was evident in Calls for Service, UP in Indian Shores, DOWN in Redington Shores.
- 2) Traffic citations were DOWN and Parking Tickets UP slightly in both Towns. Traffic Warning were DOWN in Indian Shores, UP in Redington Shores. Of the two (2) accidents (both in Indian Shores) there was no reported injury.
- 3) Physical arrests were:
 - UP 60% in Indian Shores
 - UP 75% in Redington Shores

The Department investigated 9 case in Indian Shores and 15 cases in Redington Shores. A detailed summary of those cases are attached for closer review.

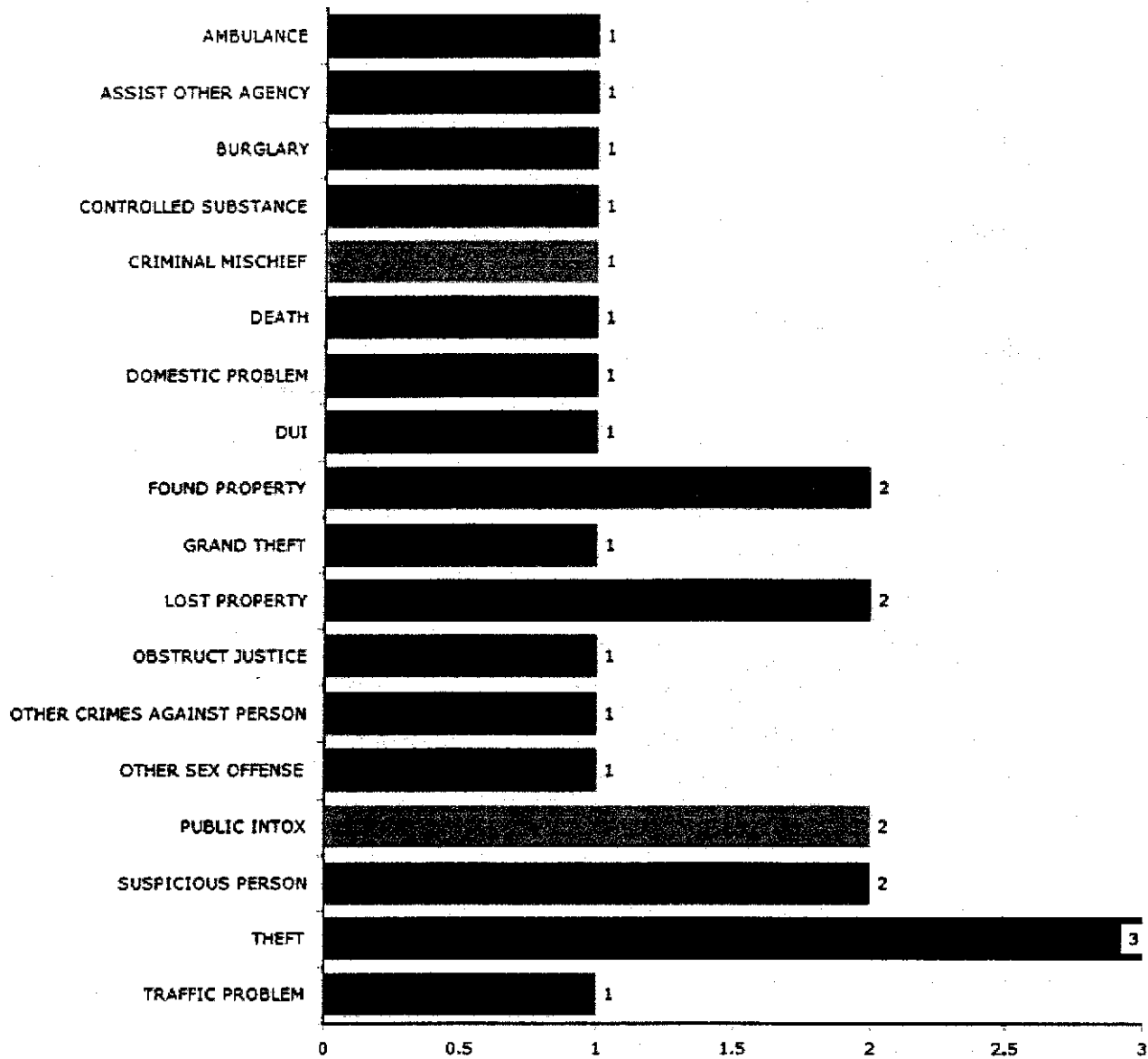

MAY 2011 INDIAN SHORES ARRESTS

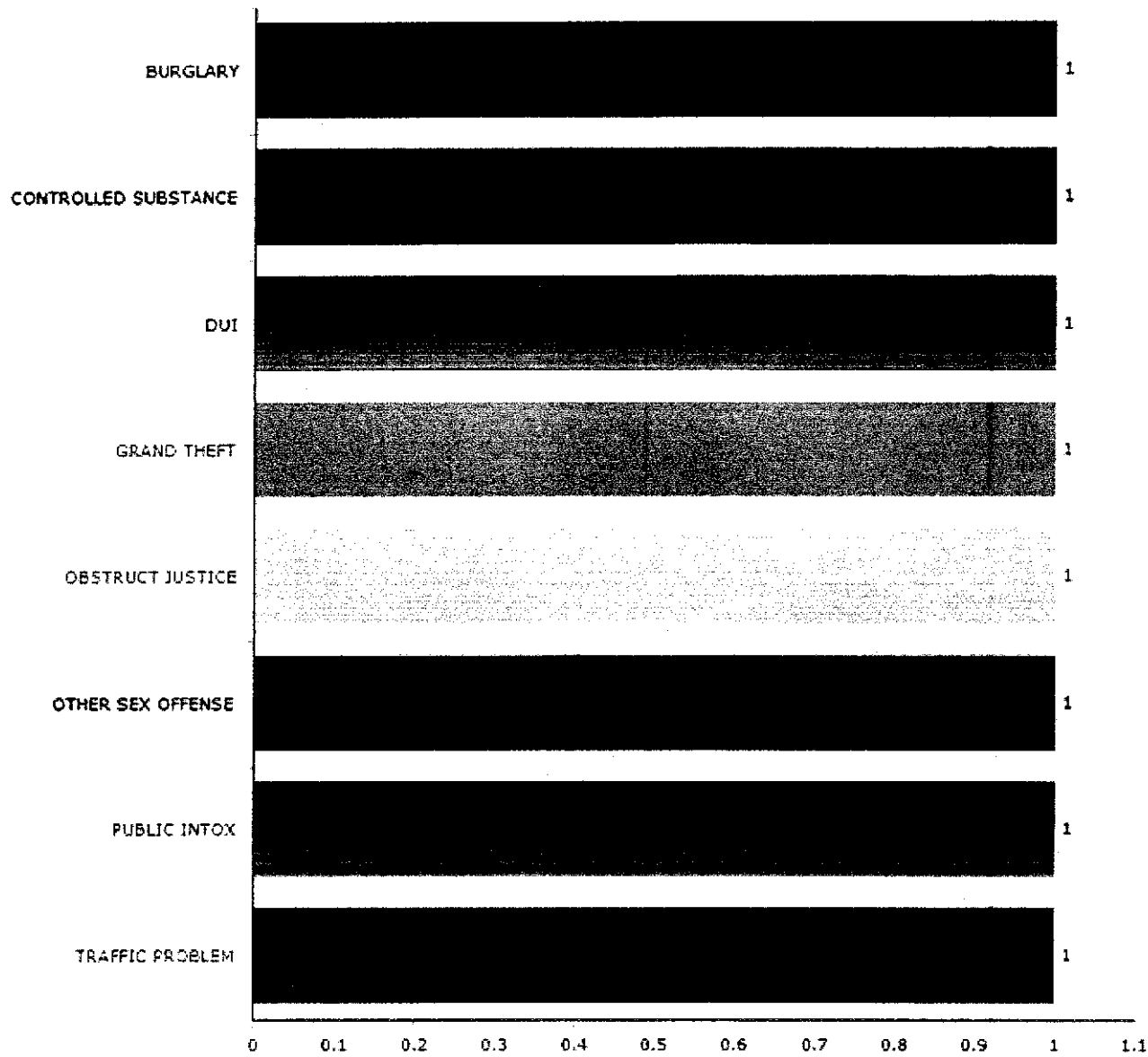
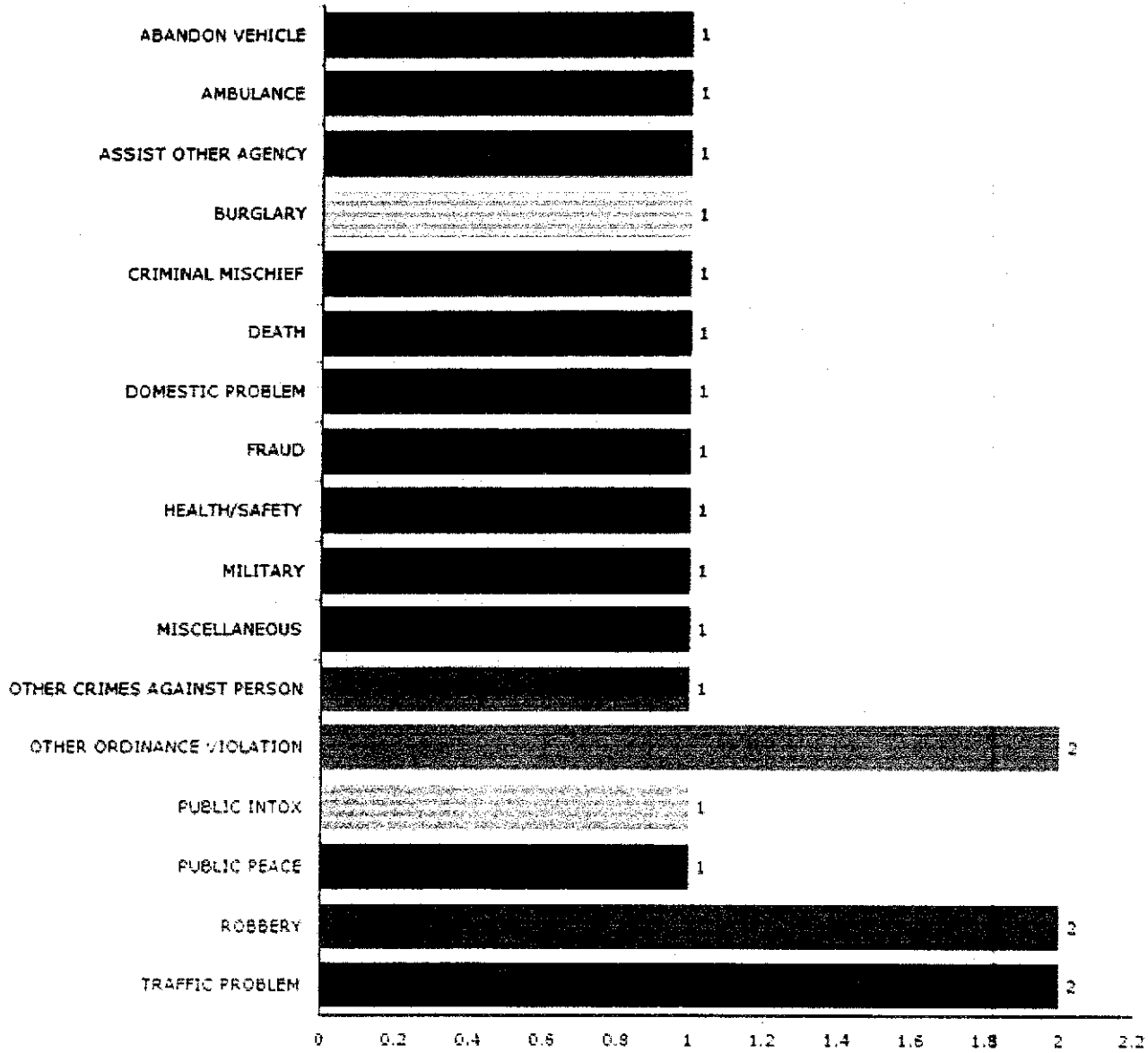
