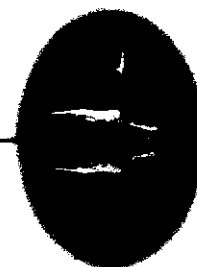

DECEMBER, 2011 MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT – PAGE 2

- 1) "Criminal Reports" and "Police Action Reports" were DOWN in both Towns, but there was a sharp INCREASE in "Calls for Service" in both Towns.

- 2) "Traffic Citations" and "Parking Tickets" were DOWN in both Towns. However, there was a substantial INCREASE in Traffic Warnings for both Towns. There was only one reported accident in Indian Shores with no reported injuries.

- 3) Physical arrests were:
 DOWN 25% in Indian Shores
 UP 38% in Redington Shores

The Department investigated **2** cases in Indian Shores and **10** cases in Redington Shores. A detailed summary of those cases are attached for closer review.

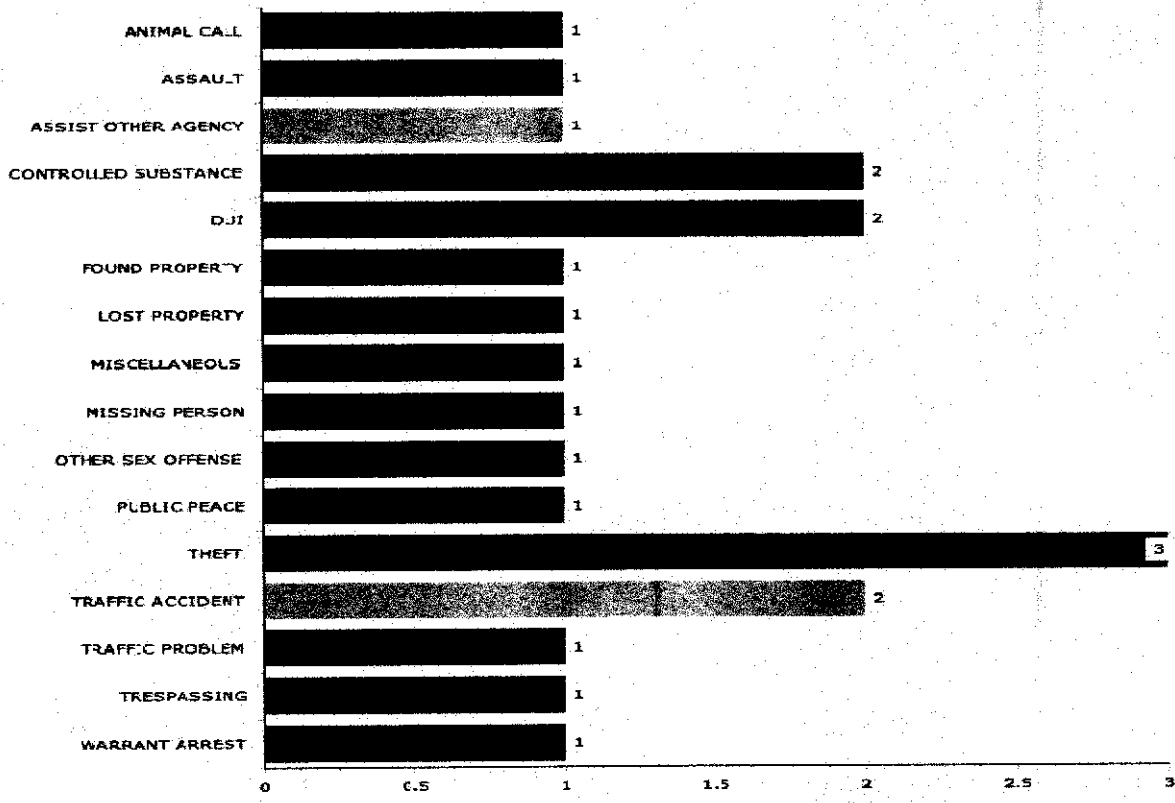

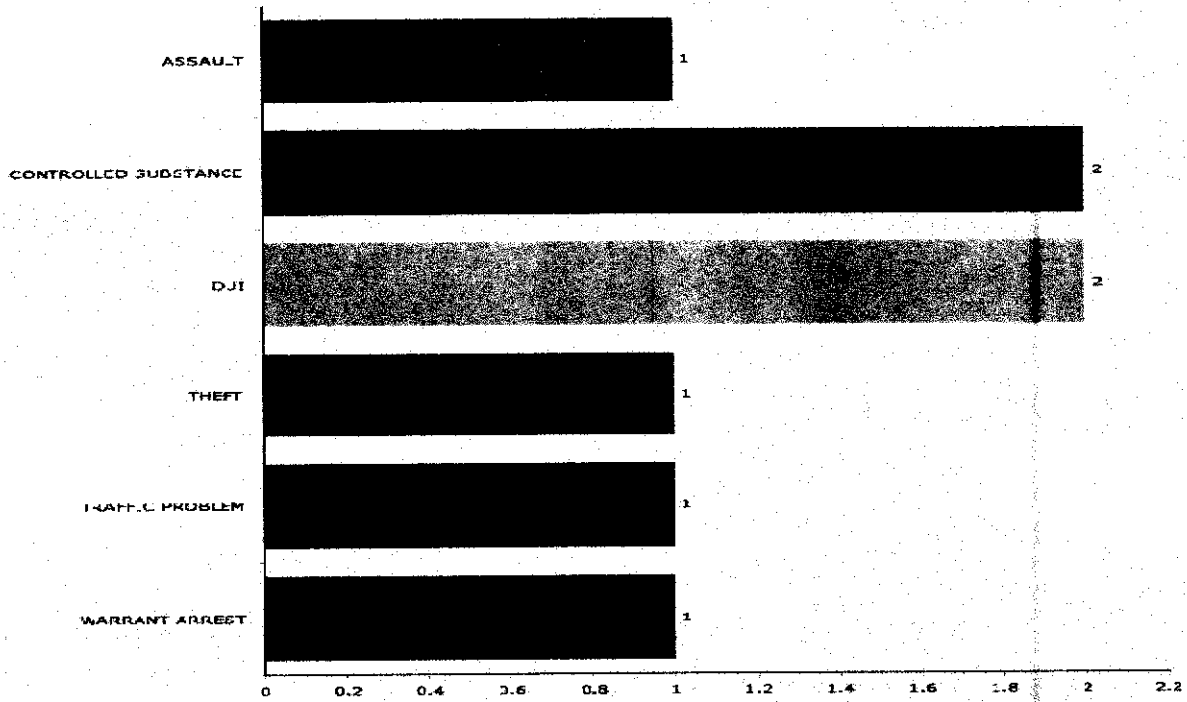

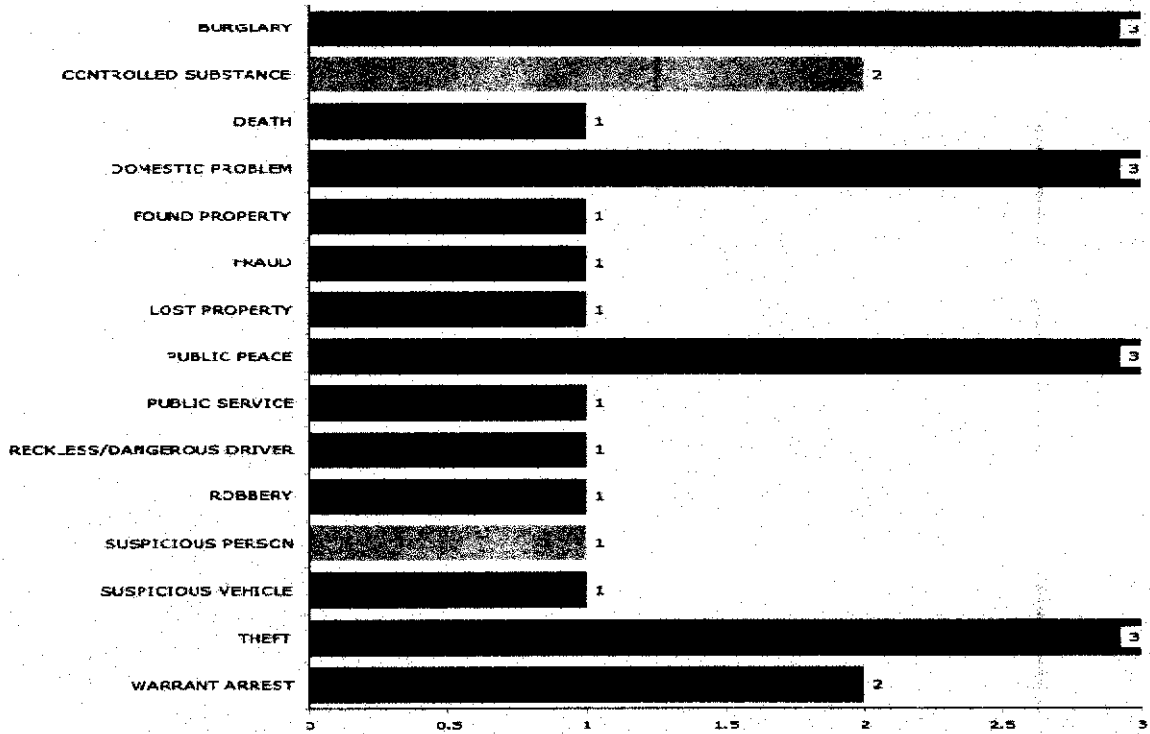
