**Must Close (April 7, 2020)**

**The Following Are Not Essential Services and CANNOT Operate or Be Open:**

- Arts (creative and performing)
  - Art studios
  - Craft studios
  - Dance studios
  - Music lessons
- Auction houses
- Boats (including kayaks)
  - Charters (fishing, sightseeing, etc.)
  - Dealerships
  - Kayak sales
  - Rentals (including boat clubs)
- Car washes (commercial, including self-serve)
- Entertainment establishments
  - Adult entertainment
  - Bowling alleys
  - Concert halls
  - Country clubs
  - Dance clubs
  - Fraternal organizations
  - Museums
  - Movie Theaters
  - Pool halls
  - Social clubs
  - Zoos
- Florists
- Garage sales, estate sales, etc.
- Personal care & wellness
  - Acupuncture (unless under the care of a medical provider)



## **Non-Essential Services and Activities Must Close (April 7, 2020)**

- Barber shops
- Gyms (including personal training)
- Hair braiding, cutting, or styling
- Massage (unless under the care of a medical provider)
- Nail care
- Piercing
- Pilates studios
- Spas of any type (including day spas)
- Tattooing
- Yoga studios
- Pets & pet care
  - Pet grooming (including mobile and co-located with pet retail stores)
  - Primary Pet sales (stand-alone pet sales- however, small animal sales, e.g. hamsters, are permitted in stores like Petland who sell pet supplies)
- Pools –all non-single family non-residential pools and pool decks must be closed
- Playgrounds – all closed
- Rental shops
  - Amusement rental
  - Clothing and shoe rental or consignment
  - Games
  - Toys
- Repair shops
  - Automotive tint & accessory
  - Jewelry
  - Shoes
  - Sporting goods
  - Tailors and alteration



**Non-Essential Services and Activities**  
**Must Close (April 7, 2020)**

- Stores
  - Antique
  - Art supplies
  - Automotive accessory & tint
  - Beauty supply
  - Bookstores
  - CBD sales or other similar products
  - Clothing and shoe retail
  - Crafts (e.g., JoAnn's, Hobby Lobby, Michaels, however UPS Store Inside is allowed to operate)
  - Décor
  - Furniture stores of all types
  - Games
  - Hobby
  - Jewelry
  - Lighting
  - Music and musical instruments
  - Optical (non-prescription)
  - Skin care
  - Spa & hot tub sales
  - Sporting goods
  - Stereo sales and installation
  - Tobacco (including smoke and vape shops)
  - Toys
  - Vitamin shops (unless under the care of a medical provider)
