### **Monday, February 13, 2023, is the deadline to register to vote in the March 14 Municipal Elections**

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters that **Monday, February 13**, is the deadline to register to vote for the March 14 Municipal Elections. Voter registration applications are available at any Supervisor of Elections Office or online at [VotePinellas.gov](https://VotePinellas.gov).

Voters who are already registered to vote in Florida do not need to re-register but are encouraged to check and update their signature, name, address, party affiliation and mail ballot request as needed.

All updates can be made either online at [VotePinellas.gov](https://VotePinellas.gov), by calling (727) 464-VOTE (8683), or by emailing [election@votepinellas.gov](mailto:election@votepinellas.gov). Applicants must provide name, date of birth, and either Florida Driver License number, Florida Identification card number or the last four digits of their Social Security number.
