

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-2023**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN SHORES, FLORIDA, DISSOLVING AD HOC COMMITTEES THAT HAVE COMPLETED THEIR ESTABLISHED PURPOSE, INCLUDING THE AUDITOR SELECTION COMMITTEE, GULF BOULEVARD PLANTING COMMITTEE, AND THE ARTS COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS 3-2022, 6-2017, 20-2014, AND 19-2014 AND PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Town of Indian Shores, Florida, is a municipal corporation governed by a Town Council and vested with Home Rule authority to act for a public purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town established the Arts Council under Resolution 19-2014, which provided for expiration of the Council if not renewed every three (3) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town established the Gulf Boulevard Planting Committee under Resolutions 20-2014 and 6-2017, the latter of which extended the existence of the Committee for an additional three (3) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town established the Auditor Selection Committee in accordance with the provisions of Fla. Stat. § 218.391, and utilized the statutory process to select a qualified Auditor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to acknowledge and memorialize the dissolution of the above referenced ad hoc committees after the successful completion of their assigned purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN SHORES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the Town Council hereby finds the above statements to be true and correct, and incorporated as part of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** That the Town Council hereby repeals Resolutions 3-2022, 6-2017, 20-2014, and 19-2014 pertaining to the Auditor Selection Committee, Gulf Boulevard Planting Committee, and Arts Council, respectively.

**Section 3.** That all Resolutions or portions of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4.** If any provision of this Resolution, or the legality of any decision ratified by the Resolution, is ever found to be invalid or unenforceable as a matter of law by a court of competent jurisdiction, the offending provision shall be stricken and the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

**Section 5.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and adoption in the manner provided by law.

The above and foregoing Resolution, upon Motion by Councilor Bill Smith and seconded by Councilor Ellen Bauer, was duly approved and adopted at a regular Town of Indian Shores Town Council meeting held on the 9th day of May, 2023.
