A PROCLAMATION OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN SHORES, DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2023 AS NATIONAL BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, National Breast Cancer Awareness Month (NBCAM) educates women about the importance of early detection for breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, since NBCAM's inception, mammography use has doubled, and breast cancer death rates have declined and considerable progress has been made in the fight against breast cancer; however, it remains the second leading cause of cancer deaths among women in our country; and

WHEREAS, many women are utilizing mammography at regular intervals there are still many who are not. Breast cancer deaths could further decline if all women age 40 and older receive mammograms annually; and


WHEREAS, during National Breast Cancer Awareness Month we reaffirm our commitment to support breast cancer research, and to educate all Americans about its risk factors, detection, and treatment; and

WHEREAS, as we display pink ribbons on our lapels and in our offices and storefronts, we support those courageously fighting breast cancer and honor the lives lost to this devastating disease.
